



3. Fold white flap down.










- Secure an individual flag around a straw or stick for a single, wave-able flag.














1. Print the flag designs you want use.

3. Fold each individual flag in half so the blank sides touch.




- 4. Secure the blank sides together, with glue or tape.

- Secure an individual flag around a straw or stick for a single, wave-able flag.















