Three Words Me / Me by Me



Three Words Me

This is a great activity for the start of the year

Each child in the class chooses three words to describe themselves. (Use our list of suggested words or make up your own).

Discuss or the meanings of the more unusual words with the class so they can choose from a wider range.

Use photographs or artwork (see 'Me by Me' activity) to make a class display.

Children could experiment with different ways of writing the words using different practical or digital methods.

Me by Me

Print colour photographs of the children's faces onto plain paper.

Carefully cut down the centre of each face and stick one half onto a plain piece of paper.

Children can use different materials to complete the remaining half of their face (e.g. coloured pencils, paint, fabric, etc).

*Note - Left-handed children will probably prefer to complete the left side of their face and right-handed children the right side.

(This exercise could be paired with the 'Three Words Me' activity).
